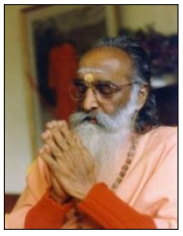

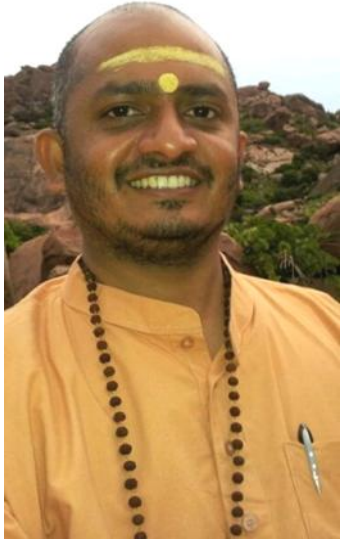

The ***Mahābhārata***, depicted by the genius and master-mind of **Vyāsa**, contains tales of high moral value, legends and myths that were prevalent at that time, philosophical discussions and historical scrap-bits, but all these are held together and worked out in elaborate detail with artistic frills upon the framework of the story of a fratricidal war which took place between two branches of a Royal family.

The ***Mahābhārata*** is even called the Fifth *Veda* because of the treasures of wisdom it contains in about one hundred thousand couplets and it is often said that what is not explained in the ***Mahābhārata*** is not worth knowing.

In this *Jñāna Yajña*, **Swami Sarveshananda** will address some of the principal topics from the ***Mahābhārata*** such as ***Yakṣa praśna***, ***Vidura nīti***, ***Sanaka sajjātiya*** and ***Viṣṇu sahasranāma***.
